

LSfM conference achievement awards

The LSfM is offering 6 conference awards to early stage career researchers who represented the Luxembourg Research Community at an international microbiology scientific event in 2023.

Application deadline: March 31st, 2024

Personal achievement-based award

The LSfM award is a personal merit-based conference award based on a lump sum of **250 EUR** for the active participation or co-organisation of a conference, a seminar, a workshop or a training promoting or representing the Luxembourg microbiology research community.

Who can apply?

Early stage career researchers (PhD students and Post-doctoral fellows within 5 years of their PhD graduation) who are member of the LSfM and who have a link to Luxembourg (not yet a member? Register at https://microbiology.lu/plans/register/).

Application, deadline and decision

For the application to be complete, the following documents should be submitted:

- the LSfM conference award application form, completed and signed,
- a CV of the applicant (maximum 2 pages),
- a copy of the conference/seminar/workshop/training attendance certificate,
- the presented poster or presentation in .pdf (if applicable),
- and a personal report about the event attended or co-organised (1 page, plus a photo if possible). In case of co-organisation of an event, please clearly state your contribution.

No cost statement or receipt is required.

The deadline for application is **March 31**st, **2024** for events that took place in **2023**. Upon submission of their application (email to **secretary@microbiology.lu**), applicants agree to the full acceptance of the rules and to the decision taken by the LSfM.

The selection criteria are based on the active and successful role of the candidates during the conference, their CV and the conference report. The grantees will be announced by LSfM at the 7th Luxembourg Microbiology Day taking place on May 16th, 2024 at the University of Luxembourg in Belval.
